No medication (prescription or over-the-counter) may be given by school personnel without the signed permission of parent or guardian. **All medications must be brought to the office by the parent or guardian in the original, current container or prescription bottle.** (Pharmacists are usually more than willing to divide a prescription between two bottles.) **Do not send medications of any type to school by backpack.** This includes vitamins, cough drops and throat lozenges.
