

**State of Florida
School Entry Requirements 2009-2010**

Physical Examination Requirements

At the time of enrollment or registration, students entering a Florida school for the first time must provide a “valid” physical examination that has been completed within the prior twelve months (Florida form DOH 3040).

All children must have a fully completed blue Florida Certificate of Immunization Form DOH 680 at the time of registration.

Immunization Requirements

Preschool – Prekindergarten (4 yr old)

4 DTP/DTap - Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis
3 HIB
3 Polio
1 MMR – Measles, Mumps, Rubella
3 Hep B – Hepatitis B
1 Chicken Pox – Varicella

- Either 1 Varicella vaccination (chicken pox), or medical documentation of the disease

5 year old Prekindergarten

5 DTP/DTap – Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis
4 Polio
2 MMR – Measles, Mumps, Rubella
3 Hep B – Hepatitis B
2 Chicken Pox – Varicella

- Either 2 Varicella vaccinations (chicken pox), or medical documentation of the disease

Kindergarten – Grade 1

5 DTP/DTap – Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis
4 Polio
2 MMR – Measles, Mumps, Rubella
3 Hep B – Hepatitis B
2 Chicken Pox – Varicella

- Either 2 Varicella vaccinations (chicken pox), or medical documentation of the disease

Grade 2 – Grade 5

5 DTP/DTap – Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis
4 Polio
2 MMR – Measles, Mumps, Rubella
3 Hep B – Hepatitis B
1 Chicken Pox – Varicella

- Either 1 Varicella vaccination (chicken pox), or medical documentation of the disease

Grade 6

5 DTP/DTap – Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis
4 Polio

Grade 7

Received after age 7
(recommended age 11-12)

Grade 8

4 Polio
2 MMR – Measles, Mumps, Rubella
3 Hep B – Hepatitis B
1 Varicella – Chicken Pox

- Either 1 Varicella vaccination (chicken pox), or medical documentation of the disease

1 Tdap (Tetanus-Diphtheria, Pertussis booster)
or 1 Td booster (Tetanus-Diphtheria)
Received after age 7
(recommended age 11-12)

Grade 9 – Grade 12

5 DTP/DTap – Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis
4 Polio
2 MMR – Measles, Mumps, Rubella
3 Hep B – Hepatitis B
1 Tdap (Tetanus-Diphtheria, Pertussis booster)
or 1 Td booster (Tetanus-Diphtheria)
Received after age 7
(recommended age 11-12)
