

Middle School Supply List

One (1) three-ring binder (recommended three-inch ring, D rings put less stress on papers) *binders only, no Trappers with zippers around. Organizational systems like the binder help students to be more aware of pressing work as well as make it easier for them to store and locate past materials.

One (1) personal pencil pouch (Seacrest has solid color pouches available to provide, although, many MS students enjoy expressing their own style with their pencil pouch)

Seacrest will provide subject folder dividers with pockets and tabs, several sheet protectors, and daily planners as part of our Executive Functioning Program.

At home supplies to have on hand throughout the year:
