



## Financial Terms 2018-2019

### Application Fee

A \$75.00 non-refundable application fee must accompany the application.

**New Student Fee:** In addition to the Deposit, an initial non-refundable, non-transferable New Student Fee of \$500.00 is required to be submitted with the Contract by the Enrollment Date.

### Methods of Payment (Per Student)

- **Plan A:** Initial deposit with signed contract is \$2,500.00. There is a \$250.00 discount, for Pre-K through grade 12, and no monthly service fee. Tuition Assistance recipients are not eligible for the Plan A discount. Balance due on or before June 1.
- **Plan B:** Initial deposit with signed contract is 10% of the tuition. This is a monthly payment plan which includes a \$20.00 monthly service fee. Monthly payments are deducted from a bank account or charged to a credit card starting **March 2018 through December 2018**.
- Deposits are deducted from the total tuition owed, but are neither refundable nor transferable once a space has been reserved, unless tuition assistance is deemed insufficient.

### Tuition Insurance (Per Student)

Coverage is **required for Plan B** participants and is optional, yet strongly encouraged for Plan A participants. The insurance rate is 1.6% of the annual tuition. Insurance Fee for Plan A participants is due on or before June 1, 2018. Plan B participants are billed in full in July 2018. The tuition insurance rates are as follows: Preschool \$113.12 (partial days) or \$205.44 (full day); Prekindergarten and Kindergarten \$321.28; First through Fifth Grades \$324.96; Sixth through Eighth Grades \$343.20; and Ninth through Twelfth Grades \$388.80.

## **Additional Fees – not applicable to all students**

**Senior Fee:** \$500.00 per grade twelve student. This fee supplements the costs associated with college applications and graduation. Plan A participants pay the Senior Fee on or before June 1, 2018. Plan B participants Senior Fee will be included in the monthly payments.

**Textbooks:** Upper School students purchase textbooks online through [www.mbsDirect.net](http://www.mbsDirect.net). Textbooks are provided at no cost for Lower and Middle School students.

**Athletic Fees:** Middle and Upper School students who participate in Seacrest team athletics will be charged \$50.00 per season/sport.

**Before/After School Programs:** Before-School care is available starting at 7:30 a.m. at no charge. The After-School program is available each day following dismissal until 5:30 p.m. Younger siblings and carpool riders waiting for Middle and Upper School students to be dismissed to other carlines are not charged. Seacrest Enrichment Activities (S.E.A.) are also available to Lower and Middle School students. Pricing is available before each quarter session.

**Bus Service:** Seacrest Country Day School provides transportation from southern Lee County each morning. The bus stops are subject to change each year dependent upon interest. Transportation costs for the 2018-2019 school year will be available before the start of the school year. The 2017-2018 rates: \$1000.00/year, \$500.00/semester, and \$12.00/daily. Sibling discounts are available. Transportation will be billed in August in accordance with the selection made on the bus information online form.
