



Dear Parents and Students in the class of 2021,

This fall each upper school student at Seacrest will take part in a retreat designed to encourage personal growth and class bonding.

This year the sophomore class will travel to Camp Cedarkirk in Lithia, Florida. The dates for the trip are September 24-26. Buses will depart Seacrest on Monday morning and return to campus late on Wednesday afternoon.
